Supporting the Development of Engineers' Interdisciplinary Competence

Background: Although interdisciplinary education has been a subject of interest and debate for decades, few investigations of interdisciplinary education exist. Existing studies examine the effects of interdisciplinary experiences on students' development of generic cognitive skills but not the development of interdisciplinary competencies.

1. Congratulations to Kathy Harper who presented “The OSU Honors Robotics Project: An Authentic Engineering Learning Experience” at the Science Education of Ohio’s 2018 Symposium.

  - Building a Supportive Community: Preventing Sexual Misconduct and Relationship Violence: This is a 60-minute online course that covers how to prevent as well as receive and respond to reports of sexual misconduct including sexual assault, relationship violence, and stalking.
